- Knowledge of the way we shop has changed over time e.g. online shopping

Computing

This term we will be continuing our computing journey by covering a unit called 'Lego Builders'. We will look at :

- What is an instruction?
- What must an algorithm be?
- What does 'debug' mean?

P.E.

This term the children will be learning about balance and stance. We will be learning to:

- Travel on the floor and on apparatus
- Develop good body tension to hold a shape
- Use different body parts to perform a sequence of moves

Where Children Come First

Art/DT

This term in D.T we are learning how to make a fruit smoothie. We will learn:

- The 5 food groups and the importance of a balanced diet
- Where our food comes from (plants and animals)
- Different ways to prepare food e.g. grating, peeling, slicing

PHSE

This term the children are learning about keeping safe.. We will learn:

- How to respond appropriately to adults in familiar contexts e.g. in school
- Who to speak to if we are worried
- What to do if we get lost
- To understand what an emergency is and how to make a phone call if needed

Religious Education

This term we will be looking to answer the question 'What does it mean to be a Christian?' To answer this question, the children will:

- Discuss what believing in God means
- Explore how Christians talk to God
- Learn about worship and where Christians worship God

French

This term we will learn the names of shapes in French.

Music

This term we will listen to and appraise two songs and then learn to sing and play a glockenspiel accompaniment with them for our assembly.

Science

This term we are answering the question 'Are all materials the same?' and will be:

- Learning the difference between an object and the material that it is made from.
