Race to the Frozen North by Catherine Johnson

This term we will be reading the story 'Race to the Frozen North'. We will be learning the format of letters and writing letters from the point of view of main characters in the story.

Our grammar focus is:

- Using personal pronouns in compound sentences
- Using a semicolon instead of a conjunction in compound sentences
- Writing complex sentences where the subordinate clause comes first
- Organising our writing into Paragraphs.

History

By answering the question 'What was important to the Ancient Egyptians and how did this impact their society?' the children will develop their:

- Historical understanding of a specific ancient civilization.
- Locational knowledge of Egypt and chronological understanding of the time of Ancient Egypt.
- Understanding of the roles of people in Egyptian society.
- Knowledge of Egyptian beliefs.
- Use of historical evidence to interpret an ancient society.

This term the children will be learning and improving their skills of:

Exploring matching and mirrors shapes with a partner
Developing how to turn mid-flight whilst jumping
