English

The Day War Came by Nicola Davies

By reading this powerful picture book, telling the journey of a child forced to become a refugee when war destroys everything she has ever known, we will be:

- Learning about the features of persuasive writing, then using what we have learned to argue persuasively in the from of a letter.
- Looking at how conjunctions and adverbials can be used to structure a piece of writing as part of a flashback story.

Geography

By answering the question 'What influences the movement of people around the world?' the children will develop their:

- Understanding of what migration is, and why people often leave to leave their homes either by choice or without.
- Knowledge of the different types of migrant, including economic migrants and refugees.
- Awareness of how climate change has impacted on migration with a growth in climate refugees.

Creative skills

In this unit, the children will learn, develop and apply all gym skills on the floor, through partner work and on large apparatus through focused skill development, sequence creation and games.

<u>DT</u>

Microbit

This term the children will learn how to program a microbit to create messages, respond to sound and produce pixelated images. Thy will use this knowledge to design, create and evaluate an interactive toy appropriate for an Early Years child.

PSHE

Safety in and the changing body

This term we are learning about how the effects of alcohol and social media may affect us as mentally and physically, we will also be learning about first aid.

<u>Music</u>

Creative composition

We will learn to play chords and how we can compose a piece of music using chords in order to make a piece sound musically interesting. We will explore how chords are used within music by listening and responding to existing musical pieces.

Fractions, Decimals and Percentages

- Ordering and comparing fractions

This term children will learn to use spreadsheets Their learning will focus on:

- Entering data into a spreadsheet,
- Using formulae to solve calculations
- Using spreadsheet data to create a graph or chart
